Accessing MATLAB at Texas A&M University

All students at Texas A&M University have access to MATLAB via their Open Access accounts. As of January 18, 2022, the version of MATLAB running on these accounts is 9.11.0.1837725 (Release 2021b). (In any MATLAB session, release information can be obtained by typing *ver* at the MATLAB prompt.) MATLAB 9.11, Release 2021b, was released on September 22, 2021; the MathWorks company typically releases a new version each spring (Release a) and a new version each fall (Release b).
